CESSNA'S CATCH PROGRAM POLICY Sky

When you combine earning your Private Pilot Certificate or your Instrument Rating with the purchase of a new Cessna single-engine piston aircraft, you are eligible to receive \$3,000.00 from Cessna.

To qualify, please provide all of the information and complete all of the steps as outlined below. Training prices will vary. And, as we've stated, the \$3,000.00 will not cover all costs associated with your instruction. The actual amount required will vary depending on a number of variables. These can include factors such as frequency of lessons, student/instructor relationship, levels of commitment, weather to name a few.

Individuals who obtained their license or instrument rating prior to the signing of the purchase agreement are not eligible for the program.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

1 Customers can enroll in the Catch the Sky Program via one of two options. Each option allows an 18 month window for completion:

Purchase and register a CBI kit through a Cessna Pilot Center. Private Pilot Certificate or Instrument Rating must be earned and a new Cessna Single-Engine piston aircraft must be purchased within 18 months of kit registration.

Purchase a New Cessna Single-Engine Piston Aircraft. Private Pilot Certificate or Instrument Rating must be earned within 18 months after aircraft delivery.

2 Training must take place at a Cessna Pilot Center (CPC), and a Cessna Computer Based Instruction (CBI) kit must be purchased, registered and used as part of your training.

3 In order to qualify for the Catch the Sky program, you must purchase a New retail Cessna Single-Engine piston aircraft.

A "new retail" aircraft is one that originally delivered from the Cessna factory within the previous 12 months and has not been previously titled to any entity other than a Cessna Sales Team Authorized Representative (CSTAR).

4 The program is available only to customers involved in an arm's length transaction with the CPC and CSTAR, and their owners, officers, directors and employees.

An arm's length transaction is defined as a transaction negotiated by unrelated parties, each acting in their own self interest. CSTAR and CPC employees, officers, owners and their relatives are not eligible for the program.

ONCE ALL THE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET, FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE STEPS TO RECEIVE YOUR \$3,000.00 PAYMENT:

- 1** Complete the Customer and Aircraft Information section on the attached Program Payment request form.
- 2** Payment may be made to either the customer or the customer's company. If the payment is to be made to the company, the "Payment to Company" section of the form must be completed also.
- 3** Have a representative of the CPC where you received your training complete the Training Confirmation section on the Program Payment Request form.
- 4** After you receive your Private Pilot's license or your Instrument Rating, you have 30 days from the date of issuance to fax the Program Payment Request form, along with a copy of your temporary license to the Sales Program Administrator.

Important Note: The \$3,000.00 is not a rebate. This payment may be taxable to the recipient and Cessna will issue a 1099. This is why we are required by the IRS to request your Social Security Number.
